Malawi GCF NAP Readiness was approved in March 2019 – 1st submission in June 2017; followed by 4 re-submissions in 2018

21 months; 4 rounds of review; 30 pages of review comments

Grant is US\$2.8 million for 3 years

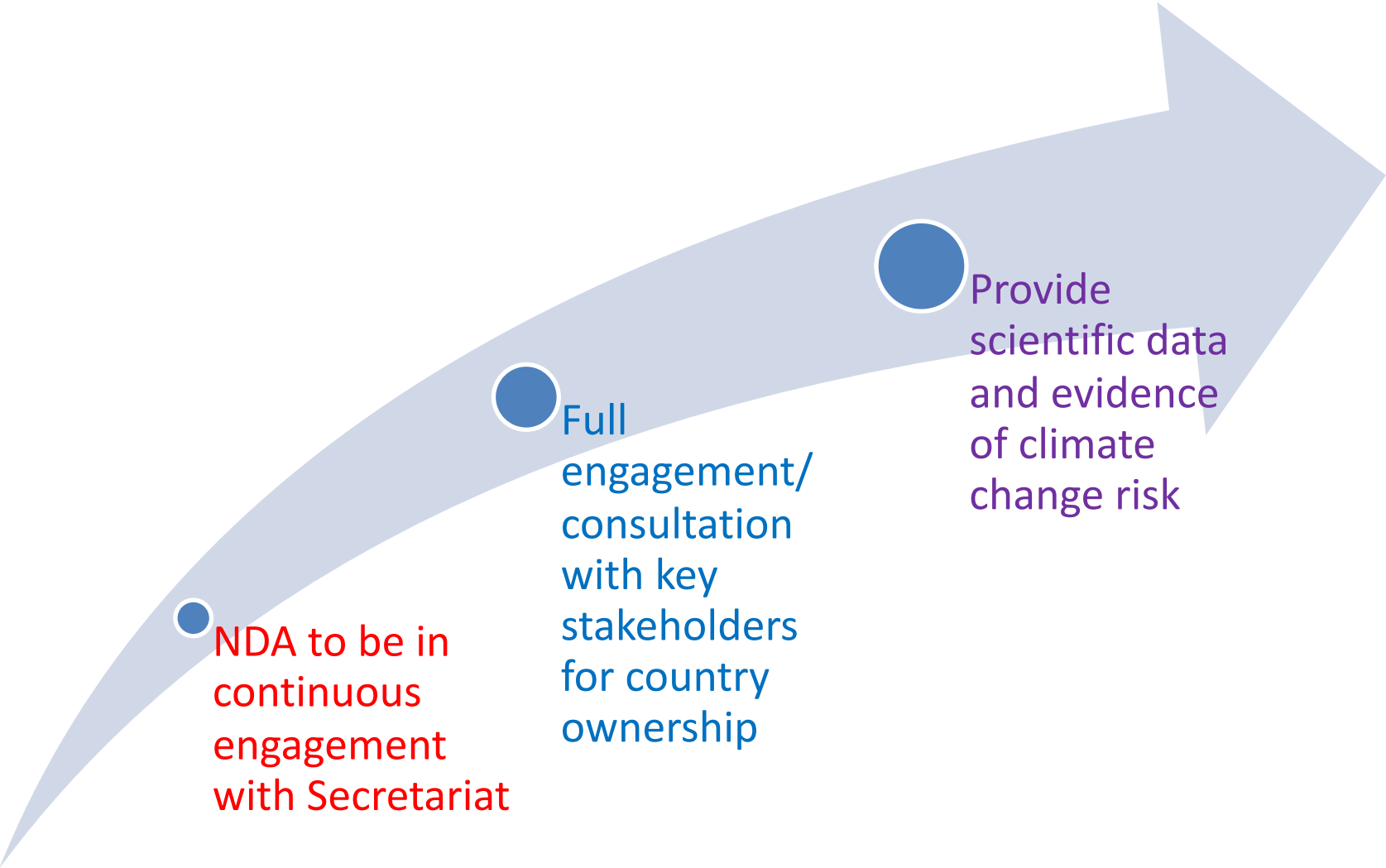
Level of justification required

1. Evidence of vulnerability of the people, economic sectors
2. Availability of scientific data to justify proposal – threats and shocks; loss of livelihoods, life, damage to property & infrastructure from disasters; displacement of people, etc.
3. Climate risk assessments to inform adaptation planning
4. Level of proposal content and budget detail – excessive
5. Small margin allowed for adaptive management – meaning Secretariat holds the key for details required in the proposal
6. Project activities and output plan may require more detailed information

Challenges

1. Role of executing entity or national delivery partner to implement the project
2. Template changing
3. Sectors wrangling as to which sector is vulnerable – to benefit
